Examination Rules and Instructions

1. All exams in Auditorium except Art in C3/C8, 12&13 DGT in B8, 11 English in B8/B12
2. The time given for each exam is stated. Wait outside the exam room until admitted by the supervisor. Be there **10 minutes before** the start of the exam. Your subject teacher will tell you what equipment to bring.
3. In the exam room no communicating with any other student. Communicate with supervisor by raising your hand. No food to be eaten. No borrowing of equipment in the exam room. No white out.
4. No cell phones, IPODS, watches. These are to be left in a clear plastic bag under your seat in the exam room. Cell phones to be switched off.
5. Students are required to stay in the examination room for a minimum of two hours for a three hour exam, 1½ hours for a two hour exam.
6. No programmable calculators in exams. Calculators may be checked.
7. From Thursday 13th September to Wednesday 19th September, all Year 11-13 students have study leave. You are expected to be at home preparing for exams or doing assignments. You should not be 'around town' during school hours. You should not be in paid employment during school hours. You are able to study at school but you are to be here for that, and not socialising.

Note: the Thursday Snowsports Programme will run.

8. If you are absent for these exams you must contact the school.

These exams are important preparation for NCEA at the end of the year, as well as providing indicative marks if you are unable to sit the November NZQA exams.

The school will follow up any unsatisfactory absences.

9. You can wear mufti for these examinations.
10. Some students doing subjects by Te Kura have examinations. They may be at a different time than the school exams. Ms Sinclair will inform these students.
11. Students with Special Assessment conditions will get an additional piece of paper that will explain the arrangements for them.
