Applicants will be competent to teach either Calculus or Statistics to Year 13 and demonstrate an in depth knowledge and understanding of the Mathematics curriculum from Year 7 to 13. The position is permanent full time and will commence at the start of Term 1, 2018. A school house is available for the successful applicant.

Cromwell College has a growing roll of around 440 students and our school curriculum contains a wide range of traditional academic and vocationally oriented subjects. - 2 Competent, trained teacher holding current NZTC registration.
- 3 In-depth current knowledge of the revised New Zealand Mathematics curriculum including current trends in pedagogy, curriculum content, assessment, etc.
- 4 Qualified to teach mathematics and mathematics with calculus and statistics to Year 13.
- 5 Commitment to co-curricular activities offered at the College.
- 6 A clear understanding of, and empathy with, the special character of a Year 7 - 13 rural school.
- 7 Possess a relevant tertiary qualification.
- 8 Evidence of a collegial approach to teaching and leading.
- 9 Well-developed communication and interpersonal skills.
- 10 Evidence of on-going professional and curriculum development.
- 11 Evidence of excellent and creative practice in classroom teaching.

Job Description

Head of Mathematics Faculty – Successfully lead and develop the Mathematics Curriculum from Year 7 to 13 so that it best meets the needs of our students.

Heads of Faculty are provided with 2 non contact periods and 2 Permanent Management Units and 1 Middle Management Allowance.

Teach up to 18 hours per week.

The terms and conditions of employment are those defined in the Secondary Teachers' Collective Agreement.

Appraisal – Teachers will be appraised against the Job Description and also against the general requirements and Professional Standards for classroom teachers and unit holders.

Key Tasks:

- 1 Be responsible for the leadership and development of the Mathematics Faculty – planning and delivery of instruction, the development and maintenance of the curriculum, development and implementation of assessment tasks and other duties as may be required for the smooth running of the faculty and the subjects taught. See the Job Description below.
- 2 Contribute to the wider leadership of the school through the Head of Faculty structure.
- 3 Teach effectively and manage the effective delivery of curriculum to students. Complete required tasks related to curriculum delivery, student management, resource management, resource development and other tasks as may arise from time to time.

- 4 Be a form teacher and contribute as required to the school's pastoral care structure.
- 5 Further the goals and objectives of the school as outlined in its Charter and its Strategic Plan and Annual Plan.
- 6 Completion of all administrative requirements in areas of reporting, attendance, duty, risk management, compliance and other matters that may arise.
- 7 Meet the criteria for quality teaching as specified in the Secondary Teachers' Collective Employment Contract.
- 8 Contribute to the wider life of the school.

- Respect deadlines for the request of information such as assessment marks, report descriptors appraisal documentation and course outlines.
- Chair regular meetings of the teachers in the Faculty to discuss the operation of the scheme, teaching methods, assessment, resources, student progress and all other matters related to the efficient and effective running of the Faculty.
- Communicate openly and effectively.
- Contribute to the middle leadership of the school through Head of Faculty meetings.
- Provide advice and guidance to staff in the Faculty including Provisionally Registered Teachers.
- Lead and encourage the professional development of teachers within the Faculty.
- Be responsible for the Faculty finances and budget oversight.
